
## Searching for a Course: Option One Catalog Search


#### Searching for a Course: Option Two Learning Center




#### **Enrollment Confirmation**

"Confirm Enrollment" to complete course registration. If you decide you do not wish to enroll in the course, you can click "Cancel" and search for another course.




#### **Enrollment Notification**
